FMC raises money to purchase food and equipment to assist qualifying agencies in procuring, storing, preserving and transporting food and other necessary items to our food insecure neighbors.

By the end of 2019, FMC will have spent more than \$52,000 on purchasing supplemental food for the MCFOODS Warehouse - which is then distributed to more than 100 partner pantries in the County - and facilitated in-kind food contributions from Community Food Bank of NJ and Feed the Hungry.
